- FRUIT:** Large to extremely large, avg 11.5g and 99.5% > 25mm
- SKIN:** Light Red
- FLESH:** Firm fruit, slightly susceptible to cracking. White Flesh.
- MATURITY:** Mid Season
- TREE GROWTH:** Intermediate cropping efficiency, upright growth habit, strong tree vigour.
- CRACKING:** Better crack resistance than Lapins and Stella.
- COMMENTS:** Eating quality is fair to good (sugars 18% acid 3.9). The variety is self fertile.
