(A South Australian **CHERRY** Variety)



- FRUIT:** Large – 10gms plus with a high percentage of crop
above 25mm. Long stalk length. Cordate shape.
- SKIN:** Mahogany.
- FLESH:** Firm.
- MATURITY:** Similar time to Lapins.
- TREE GROWTH:** Upright, vigorous growth habit.
- CRACKING:** Better crack resistance than Lapins and Stella.
- COMMENTS:** Shows good soluble solids at 17.3 Brix (Lapins 16.3)
and lower acid levels than Lapins.
The main features of this variety is its self-fertility, large firm fruit size and
resistance to cracking.
