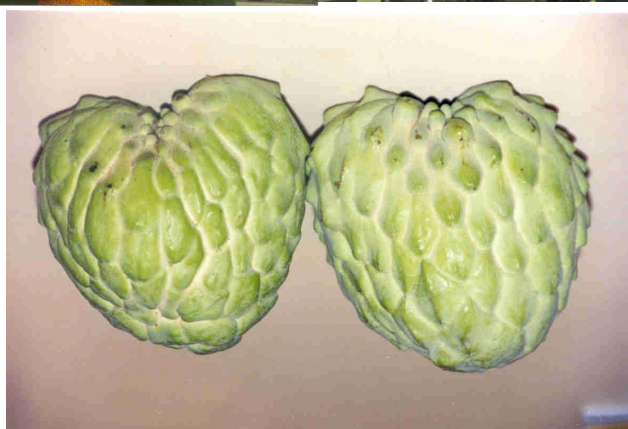



## KJ Pinks Custard Apple

- This exciting new custard apple variety sets heavy fruit crops without the need for hand pollination (41% set vs 3% of standard varieties).
- It is a self pollinating sport from Hillary Pinks Mammoth.
- This variety is well suited to high density, mechanically pruned orchard systems for viable production systems.
- Timely pruning to encourage out of season flowering will make reliable Spring/early Summer fruit possible in suitable climates.
- The KJ Pinks  Custard Apple variety (PBR# 2002/049) has been recently awarded Plant Breeders Rights in Australia and is protected from illegal propagation.
