COMMENTS:

- Low vigour
- High precocity and yield efficiency with fruit in 2-3 years
- Uniform fruit size
- Good compatibility with all varieties
- Good anchorage
- High frost hardiness
- No sucker development
- No lime-induced chlorosis on high pH soils.
- Starts bearing in the 2nd leaf
- Produces a tree about 50% smaller than OHxF 97
- Has moderate resistance to fireblight
- Trees on Pyrodwarf seem to shut down earlier and form fruit buds not the shoot tips.
