(A Henry Franklin **Peach** Variety)
Exclusive to ANFIC

- BREEDING:** Monoembryonic seedling of Kent.
- HARVESTED:** 1st to 2nd week of February, a few days after Tommy Atkins—Early Season
- FRUIT:** Size range 68 to 77 mm. Round to slightly flat shape with dimple at blossom end. Moderate suture bulge on some fruit.
- SKIN:** Red on pale cream/green – 50 to 80%. Low to medium pubescence.
- FLESH:** White flesh. Brix 12%.
- STONE:** Freestone.
- DISEASE TOLERANCE:** Superior resistance to Sunscorch, recommended in South Africa for warmer, drier mango production areas.
- COMMENTS:** Tree growth is spreading and somewhat dwarf—can be planted at higher densities. The fruit has excellent taste and flavour with distinct mango character. Excellent shelf life.
