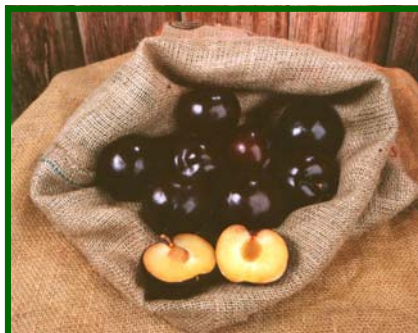


HOWARD SUN

(An Agri Sun **Plum** Variety)
(Exclusive to ANFIC)



- FRUIT:** Resembles Friar but is more rounded. Fruit is large.
- SKIN:** Dark red to black.
- FLESH:** Amber flesh.
- MATURITY:** A few days before Angeleno and 14 – 18 days before Roysum.
- POLLINATORS:** Same as Friar. Ebony Sun has been used in California.
- COMMENTS:** Howard Sun crops heavily each year. In 9 years there has been no cracking or sunburn problems. The tree is of upright growth habit.
