

SOMERSET

(A CHERRY Variety)

FRUIT:	Medium to large, heart shaped fruit with a medium to short stalk.
SKIN:	Dark red/mahogany.
FLESH:	Very firm, dark red.
MATURITY:	Mid to late season, approximately 8-10 days after Bing.
POLLINATORS:	Possibly Stella, Van or Vega.
COMMENTS:	Heavy cropper, fruit hangs well on the tree, heavy cropping may affect fruit size. Early colouring of fruit can be confused with maturity.
