

## *SOUTHERN ICE™*

(A Plant and Food Research NZ White PEACH variety)  
(Exclusive to ANFIC)



- FRUIT:** Large, round fruit (170 g average).
- SKIN:** Cream skin with a 60% red blending to pink blush. (Similar to Coconut Ice)
- FLESH:** White flesh, crisp, non-melting. 14 - 15° Brix, 4 - 4.5 kg of pressure.
- MATURITY:** Mid January in Hawkes Bay, NZ and mid February in Central Otago, NZ.
- COMMENTS:** The fruit has a noticeable aroma and the flavour is enhanced if picked at over 12° Brix, with best overall eating experience occurring when fruit is harvested at around 15°Brix. It has a high chill requirement of approx 900 hours. Self-sterile, heavy cropper.
