- FRUIT:** Large round fruit (170 g average), low-acid, clingstone peach.
- SKIN:** White skin and a red blush.
- FLESH:** White flesh, crisp, non-melting.
- MATURITY:** Mid January in Hawkes Bay, NZ and mid February in Central Otago, NZ.
- COMMENTS:** Similar in appearance to 'Scarlet O'Hara'. Best suited to growing regions with higher chill. The peach is ready to eat at the time of purchase and should be eaten when FIRM and CRUNCHY and the eating experience has been likened to that of an apple.
